

The Marblehead Board of Health will hold a public hearing on Monday April 27, 2026 7:00 PM to review the proposed Curbside Collection Regulations governing the storage, collection, and disposal of solid waste and recyclables in the Town of Marblehead. The Board will also consider adoption of the proposed regulations, including the establishment of associated trash and recycling collection fees. The hearing will include a public comment period, followed by Board deliberation on the proposed Curbside Collection regulations and fees, consideration of any revisions, and a vote on adoption. The Board will also review transfer station fees associated with Bulk Items. The hearing is held in accordance with the provisions of G.L. c. 111, §31, Open Meeting Law, G.L. c. 30A and applicable provisions of the Marblehead General Bylaws.
