ADMINISTRATION

Mary A. Alley Municipal Building

 7 Widger Road

The administrative center for several town departments, serving as a hub for day-to-day municipal operations.



ADMINISTRATION

Abbot Hall

 188 Washington Street

Marblehead's iconic town hall, home to town government offices and the famous painting 'The Spirit of '76.' A landmark of civic life in Marblehead.



ADMINISTRATION

Medical Building

 1 Widger Road

A town-owned office building located adjacent to the Mary A. Alley Municipal Building.



PUBLIC SAFETY

Police Station


 11 Gerry Street

Home to the Marblehead Police Department, serving and protecting residents around the clock.



PUBLIC SAFETY

Central Fire Station


 1 Ocean Avenue

Houses the Fire Department and Emergency Management operations. The primary fire station for the Town of Marblehead.



PUBLIC SAFETY

Franklin Street Fire Station

 Franklin Street

A historic Victorian-era fire station (Engine 2), providing additional fire coverage for the town.

PUBLIC WORKS | Department of Public Works


📍 3 Tower Way



Responsible for maintaining the town's public ways, storm sewer infrastructure, and municipal vehicle fleet.



Salt Shed


 3 Tower Way (DPW Complex)

Part of the DPW complex, used to store road salt and sand for winter road treatment operations.



COMMUNITY

Jacobi Community Center

 10 Humphrey Street

A modern community facility offering programs and services for Marblehead residents of all ages.



COMMUNITY

Hobbs House

 66 Clifton Avenue

Donated in the 1930s by the widow of businessman Samuel Hobbs. Used for community, educational, and counseling services, including the Marblehead Counseling Center.



COMMUNITY

Abbot Public Library

 235 Pleasant Street

The town's public library, recently renovated, providing library services, programs, and community gathering space for all residents.



HISTORIC

Old Powder House

 Green Street

A historic 1755 circular brick building used to store gunpowder during the Revolutionary War and the War of 1812. One of Marblehead's most distinctive historic landmarks.



HISTORIC

OKO Building

222 Washington Street

Home to the Okkommakamesit V.F.A. and located in the Marblehead Historic District (listed on the National Register of Historic Places, 1984). Also houses an antique pumper.



HISTORIC

Old Town House

 Washington Street

Built in 1727, the Old Town House is one of the oldest surviving public buildings in Massachusetts. It served as Marblehead's seat of government for over a century and remains a treasured historic landmark owned by the Town.



STORAGE & GARAGES

Vine Street Garage

 Vine Street

A town-owned storage and garage facility.
