The Marblehead Conservation Commission will hold a VIRTUAL (Zoom) public hearing beginning at or after **7:00 PM** on **May 14, 2026** on an application filed by **Goddard Consulting (applicant)** on behalf of **Monika Onusseit (owner)** for the proposed construction of a second-story addition, a deck and stairs, landscaping, and stormwater mitigation at **18 May Street (Map 11, Parcel 19)** in an area subject to the Wetlands Protection Act and the Marblehead Wetlands Protection Bylaw.
